SUBJECT ARRESTED FOR BREAKING AND ENTERING, NIGHT TIME

On May 24th at approximately 4:30 am officers of the Orleans Police Department responded to an alarm at a local business. Arriving officers Sergeant Matthew Watts and Officer David Freiner immediately discovered a broken window. A nearby witness, who heard the alarm provided the officers with additional information. Officer Freiner located a vehicle that matched the description given minutes later, still within the immediate area and quickly discovered evidence within the vehicle that linked it to the Breaking and Entering. Barnstable County CIO Deputy Sheriff Sean Percy arrived shortly after and processed the area and recovered additional forensic evidence from the scene as well as the motor vehicle. The Vehicle and attached trailer were taken to the Orleans Police Department where a search warrant was sought and executed. Additional property was identified.

Arrested was William B. Putman III, age 46 of Sandwich, and charged with Breaking and Entering in the nighttime, Possession of Burglariuous tools and use of a Motor vehicle during the commission of a felony. He was arraigned in Orleans District Court, and held at the Barnstable House of Corrections on \$5.000 cash bail.

Putman was working in town as an asphalt paver/ seal coating service, under the name Cape Curb Appeal, also located in E. Sandwich.
