

Purchase Open Burning Permit

The Town of Orleans now uses OpenGov for Open Burning Permits. Please read on for a quick user guide!

Step One: Make an OpenGov Account

- Visit <https://orleansma.portal.opengov.com>.
- If you do not already have an OpenGov account, choose **Sign Up** on the top right. You only have to do this once!
- If you already have an OpenGov account, proceed to **Step Two**.

Step Two: Log In

- Visit <https://orleansma.portal.opengov.com>.
- Choose **Login** on the top right and enter your OpenGov username and password.

Step Three: Purchase an Open Burning Permit

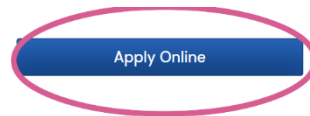
- You are only required to purchase **one Open Burning Permit** for the season.
- Once logged in, click the **Fire-Rescue Department** box on the Portal page.
- Select **Purchase Open Burning Permit**.

***Purchase Open Burning Permit**

Note: Once you have purchased your **Open Burning Permit**, you will be emailed a Burning Permit document with a Permit Number on it. Please check your spam folders if you do not see the email from OpenGov.

On days you want to burn, please return to the Fire-Rescue Permits page, select **Open Burning Permit – Burning Today**, and enter your purchased Permit Number.

If burning is currently not permitted by the Fire-Rescue Department due to weather, you will see **Open Burning Currently Not Permitted** instead.

- Fill out the application with your information and check the box certifying that you have read and understand the regulations and restrictions.
- Review your information and hit **Confirm and Submit**.
- You should receive an email notifying you that the payment fee is due (check your spam folders if you do not see it).

- Once paid, you will receive an email confirming your application was submitted successfully.
- You will also receive a second email with a **Permit Number** and a link to view the **Burn Permit** document.
