



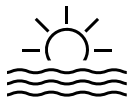

Public Use Rules & Regulations

Welcome, we kindly ask you to abide by our rules and regulations and be considerate of all other visitors in order to ensure public safety and minimize any impacts on this protected land.



Take only photographs. Leave only footprints.



Conservation Lands are open daily sunrise to sunset (except when fishing).



Please stay only on designated roads and trails whether you are walking, biking, or horseback riding.



Fishing and shellfishing, conducted in accordance with state and local laws is permitted.



All dogs shall be restrained or under the control of a responsible person at all times while off the premises of its owner (Town Code 85-2).



Gatherings of ten or more are permitted but must have written permission from the Orleans Conservation Commission.



Littering, including domestic trash disposal, is prohibited.



Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.



Camping and open fires are prohibited.



Hunting is prohibited except below Mean High Water or in a Great Pond.



Motorized vehicles are prohibited (e.g., motorcycles, ATVs).

Please help us protect this land and everything within it. No person shall alter, destroy, or damage anything on or within this land.

Penalties for any person who violates any of the above rules and regulations may be fined not more than \$100 for each violation under the provisions set forth in MGL Ch. 40, s. 8c.
