Sealed bids for One (1) new Solid Waste Transfer TRAILER will be received until 3:00 p.m. prevailing time on October 1, 2021, by the Town Administrator's Office, 19 School Road Orleans MA 02653-3699 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read outside in front of Town Hall. Specifications are available by registering at www.town.orleans.ma.us/bids.aspx. The Town Administrator reserves the right to accept and/or reject any and all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding procedures to the extent allowed by law and make the award as may be deemed in the best interest of the Town. Bid award will be made within 30 business days of bid opening.

Bids received after the noted time of receipt will be returned to the bidder unopened. Emailed or FAX bids will not be accepted. All bids shall be submitted to the Town Administrator's Office with the information and forms required which shall become the property of the Town and will not be returned unless a written request to withdraw is received prior to opening of bid.

All bidders should visit the Orleans Transfer Station, Lots Hollow Road Orleans, MA where existing 2007 Stetco Solid Waste Transfer TRAILER offered for trade-in are housed, and take into consideration the existing conditions of the trade-ins, and should the bid be accepted, the bidder will be held responsible for any omission, misunderstanding or errors related to the trade-ins. The trade-in vehicles are available for inspection Monday – Friday, 7:00 A.M. – 3:00 P.M. by appointment only. Prospective bidders should contact Highway Manager Ron Trudeau at (508) 240-3790.

Bids shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked on the outside of the envelope "**SOLID WASTE TRANSFER TRAILER**", pursuant to the specifications provided with the name of the bidder noted thereon and shall be delivered prior to the time and place stated in this Invitation for Bids. The Town will not be responsible for bids opened in error due to improperly labeled envelopes.

To be considered, all bids must be made in accordance with these GENERAL CONDITIONS:

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The Town of Orleans reserves the right to accept or reject any, and/or all bids, wholly or in part, and/or to waive informalities if it is in the best interest of the Purchaser to do so. Any form which is required to be submitted and which is incomplete, conditional, obscure, contains additions not called for and approved by the Town, or which contains irregularities of any kind, may be cause for rejection of the bid. The bid will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting the specifications. In the event of default by a successful bidder, or his refusal to enter into a Contract with the Town, the Town reserves the right to accept the bid of the next lowest responsive and responsive

bidder.

2. Should any Bidder find during examination of specifications, any discrepancies, omissions, ambiguities, or conflicts, or be in doubt as to their meanings, he shall request from the Town Administrator in writing, an interpretation or correction thereof not later than five (5) business days before the date of the bid opening. The Town Administrator will review the question, and where information sought is not clearly specified in his opinion, he will issue a clarifying or correction addendum. Proper interpretation or making of any necessary inquiry will be the Bidder's responsibility. Any questions regarding the specifications may be made in writing to:

3. At any time up to the hour and date set for opening of bids, a bidder may withdraw his/her bid. Such withdrawal must be in writing and sent to the Town Administrator at the address set forth herein by certified mail or delivered in person. Such withdrawal shall be effective only upon receipt by the Town Administrator and will not preclude the submission of another bid by such bidder prior to the hour and date set for the opening of bids. After the scheduled time for opening of bids, no bidder will be permitted to withdraw his/her bid, and each bidder hereby agrees that his/her bid shall remain firm until accepted or rejected. A bid made and opened may be withdrawn with the written permission of the Town Administrator if, in the Town Administrator's opinion, the bid is inconsistent with the best interest of the Town.
4. The Town Administrator and/or his designee will study and evaluate all bids which are received in accordance with the instructions set forth in the bid package and the Town Administrator shall award the Contract and notify all bidders of the award of the Contract within forty-five (45) calendar days of the date set forth for the opening of bids. Such notice shall be in writing and mailed to the address furnished by each respective bidder. The selected party shall execute the documents required to complete the transaction within five (5) days of notification of selection.
5. Descriptive Material: Descriptive material such as plans, drawings, photographs, diagrams, illustrations, written descriptions, and manufacturer's literature that will enable the purchaser to determine the exact quality, design, and appearance of the equipment proposed, shall accompany the bid. All equipment listed, or shown, in the manufacturer's literature, drawings, or photographs, and approved by the Town of Orleans, shall be furnished.

6. Each bidder is required to provide a complete and accurate description of the manufacturer's product along with engineering specifications. These specifications shall be in the same sequence as the specifications for ease of comparison. Any bid not in this sequence will be disregarded and rejected. Each bidder shall supply a detailed description of the vehicle and equipment, which they propose to furnish, and to which the ambulance furnished under the contract must conform.
7. Vendors Liabilities: The bidder receiving the award, shall defend any and all suits and assume all liability for any and all claims made against the Town of Orleans.
8. Purchases made by the Town of Orleans are exempt from the payment of Federal Excise Taxes and State Sales Tax and such taxes must not be included in the quoted price. The Purchaser will submit a Tax-Exempt Form upon request.
9. All prices and delivery times quoted must be firm F.O.B. for delivery to the Orleans Transfer Station address at Lots Hollow Road, Orleans, MA.
10. Before submitting a sealed bid, each bidder must make a careful study of these specifications and bid, and fully assure themselves of the quality of the materials and the character of the workmanship required. The quality of the materials and workmanship is of profound importance to the public safety of the residents of the Town of Orleans.
11. Before the award of the contract, the bidder may be required to show that s/he has the necessary facilities, experience, and ability to perform on-site warranty work and service work in a satisfactory manner.
12. No alterations shall be made in the equipment described by the specifications except upon written order of the Contracting Officer of the Town of Orleans, and when so made, the value of work will be added or deducted from the contract price by mutual agreement of the purchaser and vendor.
13. All materials used shall be of the best quality of their respective kinds. All work performed shall be executed in the most skillful and workmanlike manner. Both materials used and work performed shall, in every respect, meet the complete satisfaction of the Town. The Town of Orleans will be solely responsible for determining "Quality of Workmanship" or relating suitability of components listed.
14. The bidder shall submit a copy of all of its proposed warranties for the Solid Waste Trailer.
15. The specifications as detailed under the section **SPECIFICATIONS**, as well as these **GENERAL CONDITIONS**, shall constitute a valid part of the signed contract.

16. General statements taking total exception to these specifications shall result in an interpretation of being non-responsive and ineligible for consideration and will be automatically rejected.
17. The successful bidder will be required to supply the Town with a Certificate of Insurance as outlined in the Insurance Requirement document attached and made a part of these specifications.
18. Each bid shall include a Certificate on Non-Collusion a, Acknowledgment of Principal and Certificate of Tax Compliance, signed by the same officer as the one who will be authorized to sign the Sales Contract.
19. By submitting the bid, the Bidder certifies that he fully understands all the requirements included in the bid terms and specifications, and he is fully informed as to the nature, scope, and time frame of the type of equipment to be supplied.
20. A bid bond in the amount of five (5) percent of the bid price payable to the Town of Orleans shall accompany each bid. Bids submitted without a bid bond will not be considered and will be rejected. The bid bond must be issued by an insurance company registered with the insurance Commissioner of the State of the Purchaser. An Officer of the Bidder's company must sign bonds. Bonds issued by non-registered or foreign insurance companies will be immediately rejected. All bonds shall be payable to the Town of Orleans. Such bonds shall be retained by the Town until the Contract has been awarded. Bonds of the three lowest bidders will be retained by the Town until the execution of a contract with the successful bidder. Bonds must be in the form of certified check, bank check, money order or issued by a surety company approved to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and acceptable to the Town.
21. The bid must be signed in ink in all spaces in which signatures are required. In cases of a corporation, the signature must be that of a duly authorized officer of the corporation and officer's title must be stated. In the case of a Partnership, the signature of a general partner must follow the firm name using the term "Member of Firm". In the case of an individual, use the term "d/b/a (company name)" or "Sole Owner". The attached Acknowledgement of Principal Form must be completed and submitted with the bid.
22. 24. Force Majeure: The contractor shall not be responsible for any losses resulting if the fulfillment of the terms of the contract shall be delayed or prevented by wars, strikes, fires, floods, acts of God, or for any other acts not within the control of the contractor and which by exercise of reasonable diligence he is unable to prevent.
25. Compliance with government rules and regulations: The contractor shall comply with all rules and regulations of Federal, State and local governments and/or agencies that may apply to the equipment.
26. Payment: Payments shall be made by the Town to the supplier for all equipment specified under this bid within 30 days of receipt and acceptance of the equipment and invoice and approval for payment. 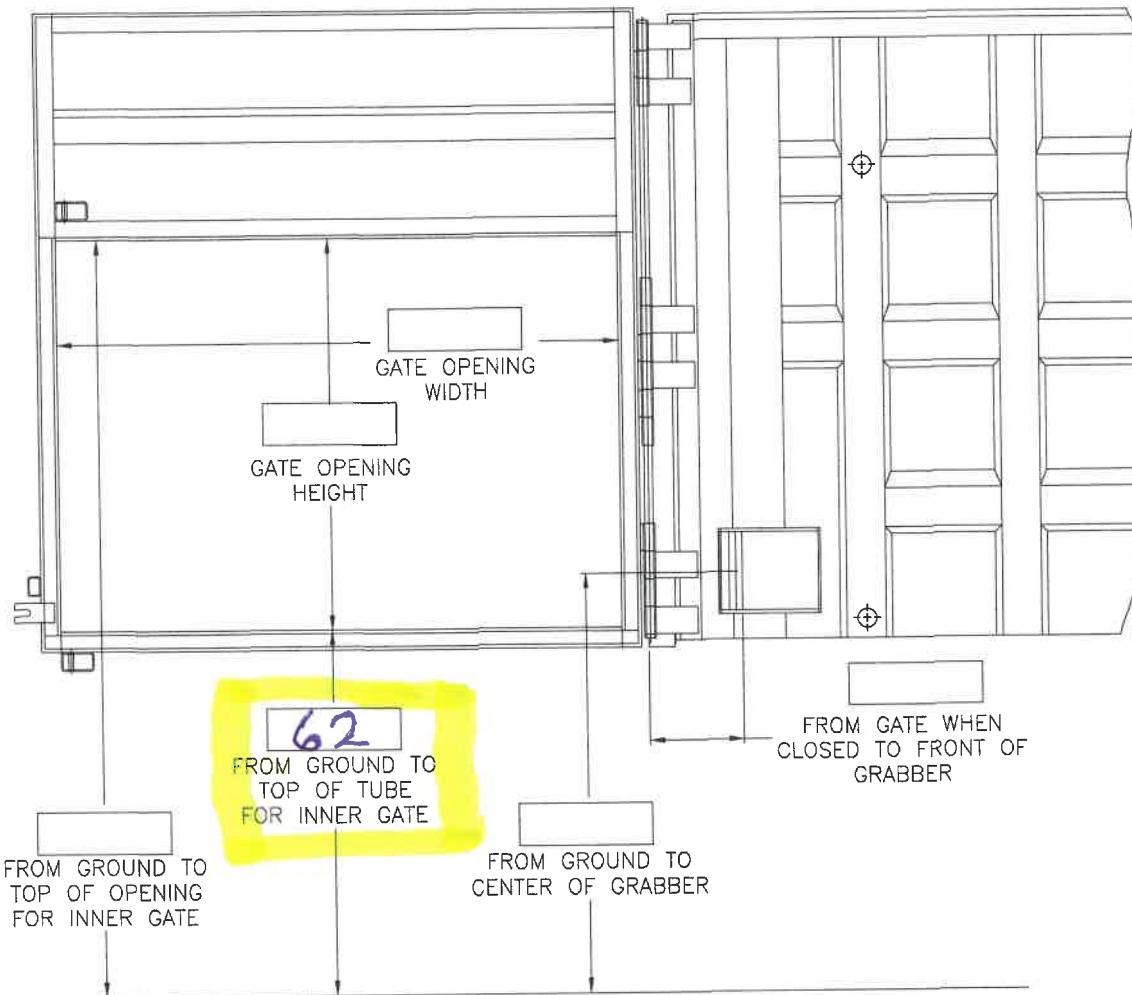

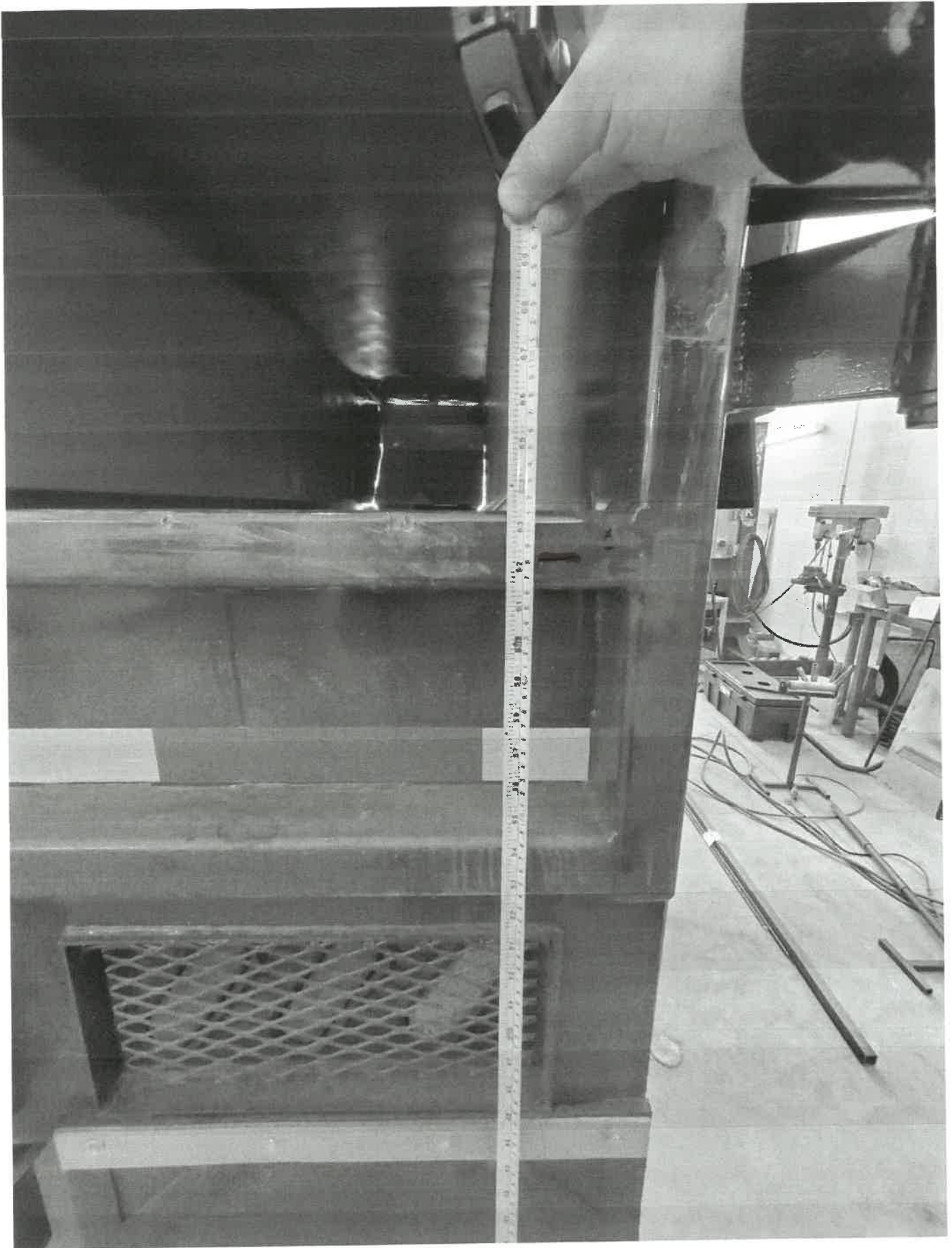
